Hershey, Pennsylvania is home of the AACA National Fall Meet with a world-class car show, exciting auctions, over 9,000 flea market spaces and approximately 1,500 show cars.

This year, Steve Babinsky has planned an extra sweet extension to your Hershey experience with a four-day mini CCCA CARavan through the surrounding countryside of the scenic Brandywine Valley and the Pennsylvania Dutch country of Lancaster County.

Our adventure conveniently begins with registration on Saturday October 13th right at the Hershey Lodge. We will make our way south through Pennsylvania Dutch country to visit the **Railroad Museum of Pennsylvania** where we will see the Commonwealth's **rich railroad history**. **Then we will wind our way through the Brandywine Valley to Winterthur.** The 175-room childhood home and gardens of Henry du Pont is now a museum of decorative arts with a collection of nearly 90,000 objects made or used in America between 1640-1860. We will also tour **Longwood Gardens** to see the intricate fountain systems, meticulous gardens and architectural grandeur of this beautiful estate. We have the pleasure to tour two private collections on this mini CARavan. The first is the **Bulgari private car collection** located on his 21-acre Allentown compound where he has seven warehouses with over 150 fully restored cars mostly from the 1930s & '40s. He believes cars are meant to be driven and they are taken out around the compound's track every day. Among his many fascinating acquisitions: Bette Davis' 1940 Buick "woodie" Estate Wagon. The second is the **private collection of Calvin High** of High Industries. A trip to the Old Spokes Auto Museum The Home of the Hudson is another must see stop. We conclude this tour with a visit to the **Morgantown Antique Auto Mall** and museum, a 336,000-ft² space with cars from the early 1900-1970s.



Activity fees are \$825.00 per person, which include all admissions to museums and meals. A non-refundable deposit of \$400.00 per entry is due upon registration and the final non-refundable balance is due on August 31, 2018.
